Places to Go

SteelStacks in Bethlehem, PA, 101 Founders Way, Bethlehem, PA 18015. I went there with George, really neat place. I would suggest you get there in the late afternoon to shoot the pipes at the east end. At night they light up the Old Bethlehem Steel Stacks. There is a Well light walk way and elevators at each end. I hope to get back before it gets too cold. Dress warm.

National Christmas Center, 3427 Lincoln Highway, paradise, Pa 17562. From what I understand this place will be closing on January 07, 2018. <http://www.nationalchristmascenter.com/> I have passed this place so many times, but never stopped. I hope I get there in the next few weeks. I understand it is best to take a macro lens as well as maybe wide angle and or 50mm. It is also good to have an off camera flash. Admission: \$12.50.

Cherry Spring State Park, 4639 Cherry Springs Rd, Coudersport, PA 16915. CSP is in Potter County. This is considered the darkest place East of the Mississippi. Here you can photograph the Milky Way as well as may constellations. There are no tree, buildings or light to contend with. Now thru the spring, is the best time to go up.
